**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:**

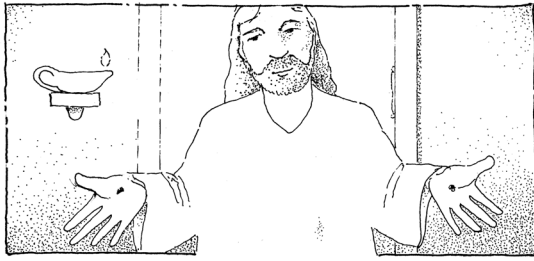
By appointment. The Diocese requires instructions beforehand for the parents. Contact the parish office.

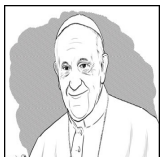
