To make Good Friday even more meaningful on a personal level. You may bring a small bouquet, or a few spring flowers that may be blooming in your garden, or just one flower, when you venerate the Cross you may lay the flower on the floor at the foot of the cross. The flowers can be tied with a ribbon, a small card or note may be attached listing the names of family, friends , and loved ones who have passed on to eternal life. It is a beautiful tribute. The flowers will remain at the foot of the cross for Good Friday and then will be collected to be placed at Mary and St. Joseph's altars on Easter.
