SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

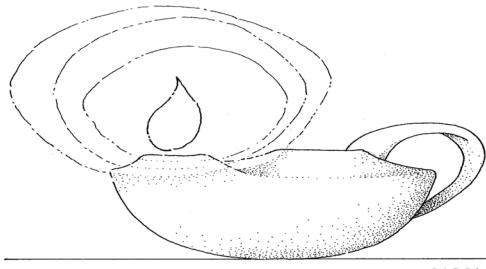
By appointment. The Diocese requires instructions beforehand for the parents. Contact the parish office.

Parishioners should be properly registered at the Parish Office

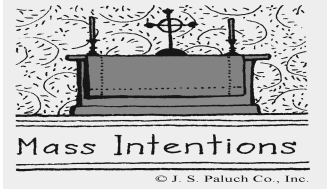
