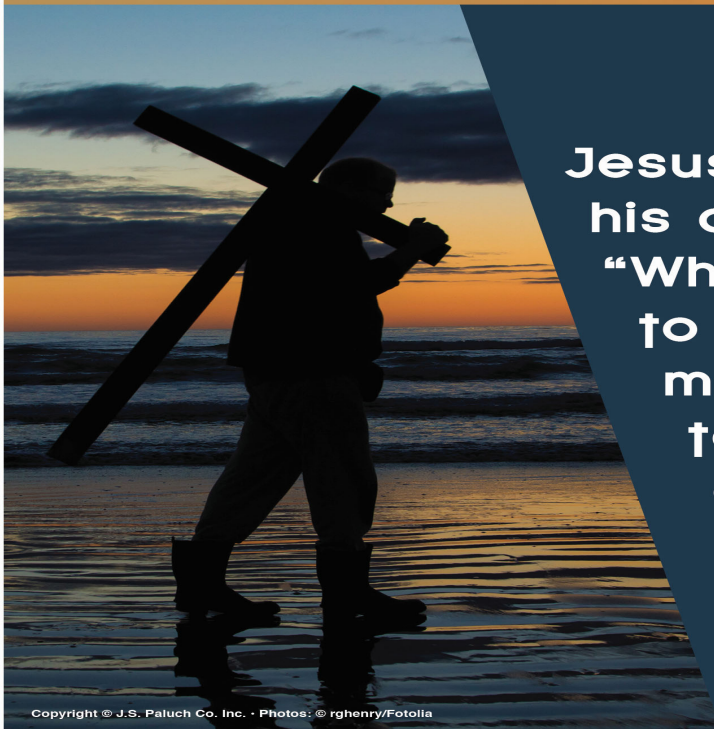

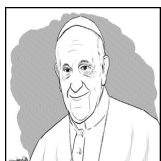
From FEMA:

REMINDER: PARISH COUNCIL MEETING


