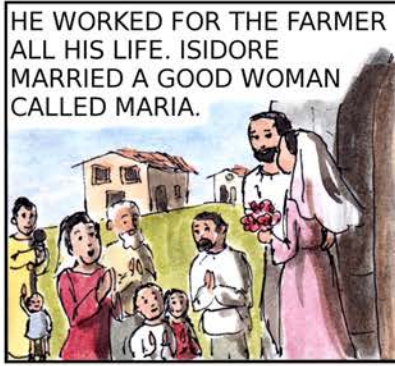
Saint Isidore the Farmer
