





There is an ancient Roman tradition to visit multiple churches after the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday night and to pray and "keep watch" before the Blessed Sacrament in each of those churches. In the spirit of this tradition, a Holy Thursday Pilgrimage will be held on the evening of April 6. We will be visiting five churches in Wheeling to pray before the Blessed Sacrament. A special booklet has been created which allows one to follow along the narrative of Jesus' time in the Garden of Gethsemane as well as provide opportunities for personal prayer and meditation.
