

GOSPEL MEDITATION: SEEING THE NEED

Sometimes, it may be hard to remember cross. However, Jesus' greeting as he that we live in Jesus' victory over sin and death, we are not waiting on it. And we, who have not seen and yet believe, are truly blessed (John 20:29), as Jesus so compassionately proclaims to Thomas in today's Gospel.

Jesus showed his Apostles great mercy, even after they abandoned him in his greatest hour of need. Only St. John the Evangelist (along with some of the women) remained at the foot of the

stands among the Apostles is not a chastisement but instead, "Peace be with you" (John 20:19). Jesus demonstrates the limitless power of his mercy as he breathes the Spirit upon them, conferring the authority to forgive

St. Thomas, sometimes called "Doubting Thomas," is the only Apostle missing during this incredible encounter with the Risen Christ. He

struggles to believe, he requires physical evidence to open his eyes to the Truth.

Is that not still true today, a suspect world where so many struggle to believe? Like Thomas, who proclaimed "My Lord and My God," when Christ reveals himself, the world must move away from temporal explanations that keeps it from embracing the Savior they so desperately need — who longs to be in communion with them.




