### **MEDITATION: A PROPHETIC STAND**

This week's Gospel presents a startling facet of Jesus' teachings as the Prince of Peace. When looked at from the perspective of discipleship, we recognize that what Jesus is asking us to consider is the prophetic stance that is part of discipleship. However, as we see in story of Jeremiah, that prophetic stance can put us at odds with those who are opposed to the truth. This was certainly true for Jesus, as well.

The challenge is that our passions especially when we take a prophetic stand

— can put us at odds with those who are opposed to the truth. As we think of the story of Jeremiah and the mission of Jesus, we know that there were some who welcomed their preaching and who were caught up in the fire of their mission. Others resisted, however, because Jeremiah and Jesus were calling for change and the comforts and complacency of these resisters were being burned up by the fire of the prophetic proclamation. This is what put Jeremiah in prison. This is what put Jesus on the cross. The status quo couldn't be maintained and the old

attitudes and behaviors had to be refined within this transforming fire.

While we are called to pray for peace, we are also called, by virtue of our baptism, to adopt a prophetic stance and call for change where change is needed. As we continue our journey through Ordinary Time, reflecting on the demands of our discipleship, recall the words of Saint Catherine of Siena, "Be who God meant you to be and you will set the world on fire."




