

meal symbolizes the journey. According to Jewish tradition, the plate has six items. For this meal, the plate contained five items: the maror, charoset, Karpas, Zeroah, and Matzo. Many thanks to those who planned, provided, and attended this special meal.


Colton Scherich, Age 8
