2. Always pray for people who are sick. Your prayers can help them get better, or they might

help your sick friend to understand why God is letting them suffer.

What about when you are sick? When you are sick or hurt, think about Jesus suffering on the cross. Offer your pain to Him and tell Him that you want to suffer with Him so

that people will be saved from their sins. Be thankful for people who help you when you are sick.


Remember, they take Jesus' place!





In today's Gospel reading, someone believed that they would be healed from their sickness if they touched Jesus' clothes.


The person touched Jesus and was instantly healed! But Jesus knew that power had gone out of Him, so He asked who had touched His clothes.
