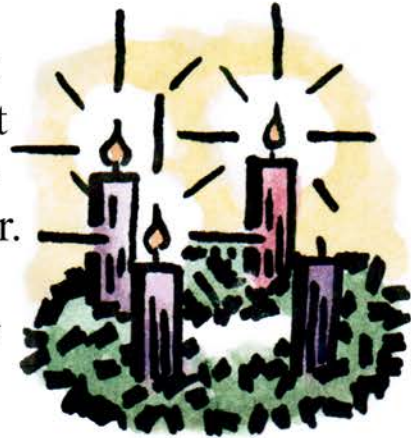


Painting the Way to Jesus

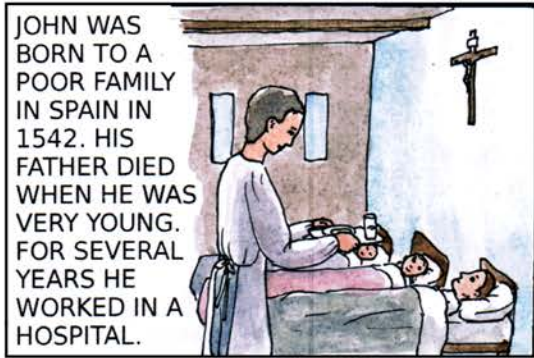


Luke 3:10-18

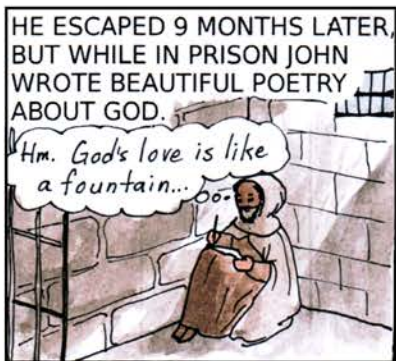

ST. JOHN STARTED A GROUP OF MONKS WHO WOULD LIVE BY THE OLD RULE.

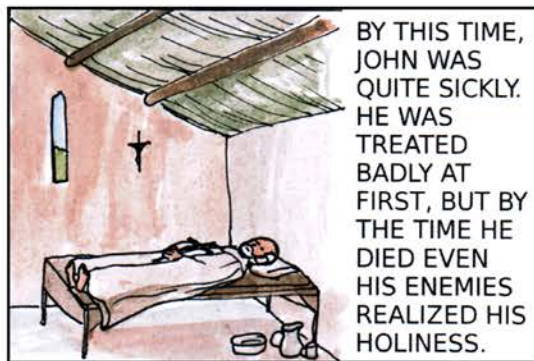


BUT SOME OF THE CARMELITES DISAGREED WITH HIM AND PUT HIM IN PRISON!

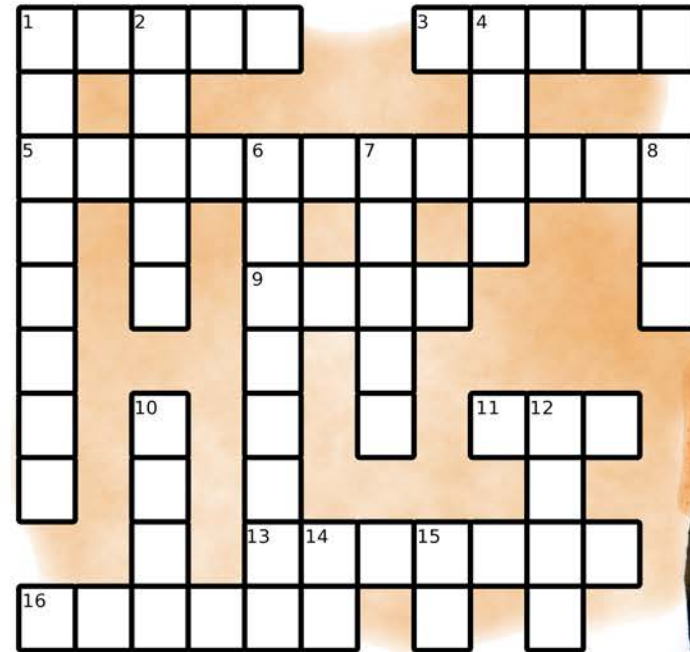
Hm. God's love is like a fountain...
